The Korean Society of Ultrasound in Medicine (KSUM) was established in May 1980. In January 2010, society members are 1,837 board-certified physicians and 238 residents.

The Society hosted the 3rd Asian Federation of Societies for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology in Seoul in 1992 and the 11th World Federation for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology in Seoul in 2006.

The Society has been providing Asian Fellowship Programs since 2008. It has been leading the discussion toward a future vision that focuses on the qualifications of doctors for ultrasound examination, education programs and resources.

KSUM 2010 *Open* is...

KSUM 2010 *Open* will coincide with the 30th Anniversary Congress of KSUM. The Society has chosen the name "KSUM *Open*" signifying that the local Congress will be open to Asian and other countries from around the world. Both English and Korean will be spoken during the initial years, but from KSUM 2011 the Congress language will be English only.


Welcome Message

The KSUM Scientific Committee is seeking abstracts for KSUM 2010 Open. The submission starts from February 4. Please check the Abstract Submission Guidelines first, and submit via the website. (<http://ultrasound.or.kr/ksum2010>).

Abstract Submission Guidelines

- All topics relevant to the Ultrasound in Medicine will be considered.
- Abstracts should contain a maximum of 500 words including a title and author information.
- The presentation formats of accepted abstracts are scientific presentation and e-poster presentation. Submitters will be asked to indicate a preference for the presentation format during the abstract submission.
- Abstracts reporting on research or investigations must include results.
- Statements such as “findings will be reported” are not sufficient and the abstract will not be accepted.
- Abstracts must be submitted electronically through the congress website. (<http://ultrasound.or.kr/ksum2010>).

Young Investigator Award

KSUM has been selecting the best speaker among the oral presenters under the age 40 every year since 2003.

Prior to KSUM 2010, abstracts submitted for this award will be evaluated. Three selected abstracts will be informed to the presenters individually. The abstracts will be presented and evaluated during the “Young Investigator Award” session (May 14, 2010). Basic research papers might be preferred.

For the awardees, a prize of KRW1,000,000 will be provided.

If you would like to challenge this award, please inform us when you submit an abstract.

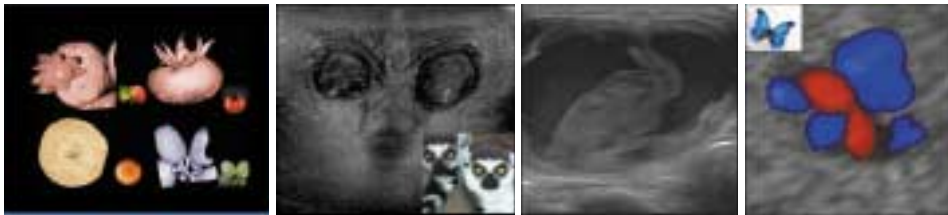

G20 : The Seoul Summit 2010

The Republic of Korea is honored to chair the Group of Twenty in 2010.

The Republic of Korea gears up to become chair of the G20 – the international committee that replaced the G8 as the world's global economic steering body – in 2010, it will also be the first non-Western country to host a summit meeting of the group next November, following on the heels of those in Washington, London, Pittsburgh, and, earlier next year, Muskoka, Canada.
